

FRENCH - LEVEL 11

Level 11 Classes: This course will suit people who have recently completed Level 10 or those who achieved a very good grade at A Level in the past or equivalent.

The content of the course will give you the opportunity to access, discuss, analyse and write in various aspects of French literature, art, cinema and contemporary issues.

Term duration 10 x weekly 2-hour classes



Key Language

- ▶ By the end of the course, you will have acquired a deeper understanding of complex syntax structures and how to use more advanced and sophisticated vocabulary in order to understand French novels, poems, articles from quality newspapers, film and art reviews.
- ✓ In the classroom, we aim to establish an all-inclusive atmosphere, using a very engaging teaching style, making each student at ease from the first lesson onwards. We endeavour to make the lessons engaging, stimulating and enjoyable by creating a convivial atmosphere aimed at facilitating great communication.
- ✓ It is assumed that you will have built up a thorough understanding of French tenses and grammatical concepts. However, revision will be done whenever appreciate, especially with the subjunctive and the past historic (essential for novels).
- ✓ Regular feedback and targets will be given, as well as weekly homework, which could take the form of a written piece, research on authors, historical contexts and new vocabulary. We understand that the constraints of everyday life might make it difficult to do weekly homework, however, weekly revision is strongly advised to fully benefit from the course.
